

Why Is Domestic Abuse So Difficult?



- It's at a **pandemic** level we only see the tip of the iceberg
- It's hard to understand
- Not enough action is taken against abusers; remember, the victim is not accountable/responsible for their abuser's violence, abuse and behaviour
- Abusers are unpredictable, the victim knows exactly what they are capable of – need to be listened to when assessing risk
- Gender inequality/stereotypes and victim blaming
- Statutory rely heavily on voluntary sector specialists
- All agencies are fixated on assessing risk, but need the victim's trust to even begin to gauge the true level of risk (only building trust leads to full disclosure)
- Cannot tell a woman what to do, this compounds the abuse **#CovWP**

What Is Needed?

- More safe housing options, resources and funding
- An agreed definition of 'Affordable' Social Housing rent
- Review Benefit Caps and Pre-Tenancy Checks those affected by DVA/financial abuse
- A review of Local Housing Allowance (LHA) Rates in the private rented sector
- Shared Accommodation Rate (under age 35) review exemptions ensure women subjected to DVA are exempt – provide same gender shared option
- Remove the threat of closure to existing specialist refuge services
- More focus on **holding the abuser to account** the victim is not responsible
- Cultural widespread training and awareness raising of the dynamics of DVA Specialism based on experience and expertise, accessible to all communities – including older women, BAMER, LGBT and disabled
- Further statutory and voluntary sector collaboration to inform practice within agencies of DVA – "lack of understanding is the root of poor judgment and poor practice"***
